Pierluigi Basso Fossali

teaches Semiotics at IULM, University of Milan, where he is also the director of the Lab of Communication Semiotics. He has published articles in many international journals and has written several books devoted to the relationship between semiotics and contemporary theories of aesthetics (*Il dominio dell'arte*, 2002), filmology (*Confini del cinema*, 2003; *Interpretazione tra mondi. Il pensiero figurale di David Lynch*, 2006), consumer science, marketing and theories of perception. With M.G. Dondero, he wrote *Sémiotique de la photographie* (2011). His most personal book is *Vissuti di significazione* (2008), the first volume in a trans-disciplinary series directed by the author himself ("Teorie resistenti," ETS, Pisa). He is the co-director of the journal *Signata (Annales de sémiotique*).

Claudio Bisoni

is Lecturer at the Faculty of Arts of the University of Bologna, where he teaches courses on History of Film Criticism and History of Reception Studies. For a long time, his work focused on the history of Italian film criticism. Currently, his main interest is the relation between the criticism and aesthetics of audiovisual texts. He is the author of *Gli anni affollati*. La cultura cinematografica italiana (1970-1979), Roma 2009; La critica cinematografica. Metodo, storia e scrittura, Bologna 2006.

Alain Boillat

is Full Professor at the Section d'histoire et esthétique du cinéma of the University of Lausanne. His research mainly concerns the history of film theories, narration and storytelling in cinema and comics, the oral dimension and the topic of intermediality in audiovisual *dispositifs*. He is the author of *Du bonimenteur à la voix-over* (2007), has recently edited *Les Cases à l'écran. Cinéma et bande dessinée en dialogue* (2010) and co-edited *Jésus en représentations. De la Belle Epoque à la post-modernité* (2011).

André Gaudreault

is Full Professor in the Département d'histoire de l'art et d'études cinématographiques at the University of Montréal, where he is director of GRAFICS (Groupe de recherche sur l'avènement et la formation des institutions cinématographique et scénique). He has been a guest professor at several universities and has published volumes on film narratology (*From Plato to Lumière: Narration and Monstration in Literature and Cinema*, 2009 – also in French, Italian, Chinese and Spanish) and on film history (*American Cinema*, 1890-1909, ed., 2009 and *Film and Attraction: From Kinematography to Cinema*, 2011 – also in French and Italian). He is also director of the scholarly journal *Cinémas*.
