THE LATEST BOOKS ON GLOBALIZATION

Five years ago, the section "The Latest Books on Globalization" made its appearance within the pages of "Glocalism: Journal of Culture, Politics and Innovation". In this way, we will continue with our best efforts to help scholars keep themselves up to date.
